## RULES CLINICS MANDATORY FOR HEAD COACHES

All head coaches must complete a rules clinic in their sport prior to the beginning of their sport season. This mandatory clinic is required of all head coaches in football, basketball, baseball, softball, volleyball, wrestling, track & field, and soccer. A school will be fined \$300 for each head coach that does not meet this requirement. The rules clinics are included in the activities of All-Star Sports Week and the schedule is provided at the right. Coaches will not be required to take a test during All-Star Sports Week rules clinics, but must register with a photo ID in order to record their attendance. If coaches complete a rules clinic online, a test will be included. **You must register for the coaching school to attend the rules clinics.**
