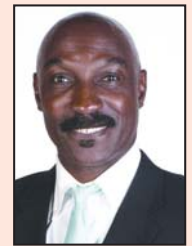

RULES CLINICS MANDATORY FOR HEAD COACHES

All head coaches must attend a rules clinic in their sports prior to the beginning of their sports' seasons. This mandatory clinic is required of all head coaches in football, basketball, baseball, softball, volleyball, wrestling, and soccer. Coaches will not be required to take an exam but must register with a photo ID in order to record their attendance. A school will be fined \$300 for each head coach that does not fulfill this requirement. Coaches may attend one of the officials' clinics at various state sites. The rules clinics are included in the activities of the All-Star Sports Week and the schedule is provided at the right. You must register for coaching school to attend the rules clinics.

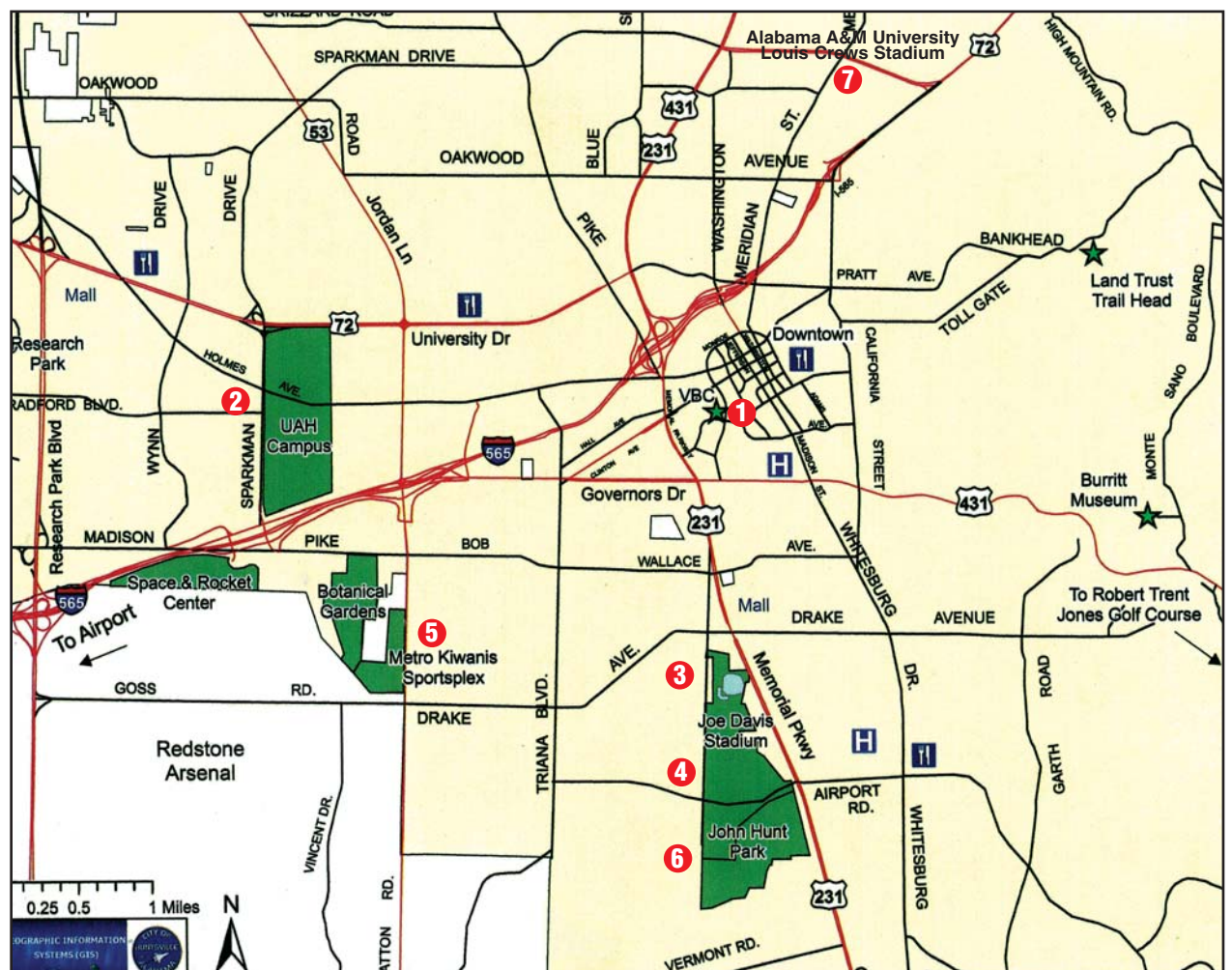
