## PLUASIL 8 (PLUACLD267) Legal Issues and the Athletic Administrator: Non-Compliance, Title IX, and NCAA Eligibility

Completion of all requirements, in a timely manner, will grant the participant eligibility for (1) Alabama Council for Leadership Development (ACLD) Professional Learning Unit (PLU).

## Requirements:

Register for conference with the AHSAA.

Register for the class with the State Department of Education on the STI PD website, located at <u>https://pdweb.alsde.edu</u>. PLU Number (pluacld267)

Attend and participate in all required sessions of the 2014 Principals & Athletic Directors Conference

Participate in online blog (<u>www.Edmodo.com</u>) discussions of the 2014 Principals and Athletic Directors Conference speakers and topics. Once on Edmodo, request to join the AHSAA/PLU group. Blogs must be in paragraph form and a minimum of 5 sentences per speaker.

Conduct a parent meeting to disseminate new NCAA Eligibility requirements.

Submit parent meeting agenda and roster of those in attendance to AHSAA. This MUST include date, time, name of presenter(s) and MUST include a roster signed by all parents in attendance. <u>A typed list of names is unacceptable</u>.

Produce a means of communicating new NCAA Eligibility requirements to parent community (handouts, web-page, PowerPoint, etc.) Submit copies of all to the AHSAA.

Conduct a Title IX Self-Study Audit of your school. Forms for the Self-Study may be obtained from the Office of Civil Rights or the National Federation of High School Associations website, <u>http://www.nfhs.org/content.aspx?id=7509</u>. Either of these self-audit tools is acceptable. The self-audit download available from the National Federation is specifically geared toward high schools and may prove to be more advantageous. Once completed, discuss deficiencies with your principal or superintendent and produce a timeline to correct deficiencies. Submit a copy of Self-Study Audit, timeline and proof of discussion with principal or superintendent to AHSAA.

Develop and implement a professional code of ethics for the athletic staff and submit a copy to the AHSAA
