

2013 AHSAA Super 6 Championships
Class 3A Final: #1 Madison Academy (15-0) 31, vs. #7 Leeds (12-3) 14
Dec. 5 – Bryant-Denny Stadium – 11 a.m.

NOTES

- Madison Academy wins the second state championship in school history. It also marks the second consecutive title won by the Mustangs after winning 31-7 over Fayette County in 2012.
- Junior RB/LB Kemoni Miller was named MVP after finishing with 168 yards rushing on 20 carries with two touchdowns.
- Madison Academy kicker Nathan Geis set a 3A Championship game record with a 45 yard field goal in the fourth quarter, breaking the previous mark of 43 set by Chandler Trach, also of Madison Academy in 2012.
- Madison Academy head coach Eric Cohu wins his 100th career game. He now has a career record of 100-21 overall (10 seasons) and is 62-9 overall at Madison Academy (five seasons).
- The 31 points the Green Wave gave up today marks the most the school has allowed in a single game all season. The previous high was 29 against Trinity on Sept. 6.
- Madison Academy set a record for the most wins in a season in school history with a perfect 15-0 record. The Mustangs have also now won 25 consecutive games.
- Madison Academy did not finish with a completed pass, marking the third time in the history of the 3A game that a team has not recorded any passing yards.
