- Muscle Shoals won the toss and deferred to the second half.
- Spanish Fort wins the third state championship in school history (2010, 2012, 2013) and repeat as 5A Champions.
- Muscle Shoals entered the game with only 16 points allowed in the playoffs and allowed just 4.7 points per game on the year. Spanish Fort finished with 35 points, the most points the Trojans have given up all season.
- Spanish Fort mean while gave up an average of 8.1 points per game during the year and held Muscle Shoals to just 14 points. The Trojans entered the game having scored more than 21 points in every game this season and averaged 39.9 points per game.
- Game MVP: Tyler Johnston –10-of-15 passing, 219 yards; 12 carries, 53 yards, one touchdown.
